

Summer 2026- Winslow Estates

June is here and the start of summer is about 2 weeks away. Below are a few reminders about activity within the association during the summer/fall months.

Lawn Mowing: Diggin Landscaping will be mowing weekly, generally on Wednesdays.

Mulching: Diggin/Ready Field Solutions completed mulching in mid-May.

Lawn Fertilization: TruGreen started fertilization and weed control in April and will be treated a total of 5 times this year, including grub control.

Pond Management: Aquadoc started pond management in April and will continue through the summer season about every 2-3 weeks. This is targeted at algae management and weed control.

Street lighting and the fountain in the pond are powered by Ohio Edison.

Trash and Recycling: Rumpke is the City of Aurora provider with weekly service. Pickup is generally on Thursday, adjusted periodically by holidays.

Retention Ponds: Retention Ponds within Winslow Estates Condominium Owners Association are designed for flood water control and installed by the original developers. The retention ponds are not considered a recreational body of water. Swimming, Boating, Water Sports in general are not the intended purpose of the retention ponds.

We recommend that each family inform all minors/children of the potential dangers associated with the retention ponds and recommend that a responsible adult be present should any activity by children take place around the retention pond areas.
